Safety Tips: Keep scissors out of reach of children. Keep all glue caps, marker caps and other small items out of reach of children age 3 or under, as they are a choking hazard. Use nontoxic washable markers only. Watch young children when they are using crayons, to be sure they don't put them in their mouths. Have an emergency plan in place in case of injury, ie. personnel trained in First Aid procedures

Gold/Silver Statue Puzzle



Statue puzzles
Puzzle outline
Gray construction paper
Words 2 page (for rock)
Metallic crayons
Regular crayons
Restickable glue sticks
Scissors (adult only)
Rocks: Give each child 1/2 sheet of gray paper to wad up to make their rock. Kids can glue rock to their puzzle page or leave it off to tell the story in their own words.

Prep: Print craft pages. Make copies of Outline page onto cardstock. Cut gray construction paper in half crosswise (1/2 sheet per child). **Craft:** Children use metallic or regular crayons to color pieces. Adult cuts puzzle pieces apart. (Keep scissors out of reach of children). Help children put restickable or repositionable glue on the backs of the puzzle pieces, and rock. You'll show children how to put puzzle together during group puzzle activity.

People on God's Mountain Craft



Options: Have children rock and people, or use one as a pattern to cut them out of construction paper.

Mountain craft page
Accordion people page
Gray construction paper
Copy paper – white or people-colors
School glue
Crayons or markers
Scissors (adult only)
Craft: Children color mountain picture, glue construction paper mountain onto picture. Kids color clothes on the people, glue hands together, then glue the two hands on each end to the picture, or use a dot of glue in the middle of each person, if needed.

Prep: Print both craft pages. Make copies of mountain picture onto copy paper. **Mountain:** Use one mountain as a pattern: Cut out, lay on gray construction paper, cut out c.p. mountains. **Tip:** Staple 2-3 layers of paper together to cut several out at the same time. **People:** Make copy of Accordion People onto people-colored paper. Cut in half lengthwise. Fold back and forth on dotted lines with the people shape on top. Cut people out (they'll be joined). **Option 2:** Use one people shape as a pattern to trace (but extend hands a little longer) and cut out of construction paper (folded accordion style, or singly out of *different* people-colors to make it a multi-cultural craft. Children will then glue them together to make a chain).

King Nebbie Puppet Stand-up Craft



Nebbie Puppet craft page
Words 1 craft page
Heavy white cardstock
Gold wrapping paper or craft paper (optional)
Crayons + metallic gold/silver
Scissors (adult only)
Extra strength glue (optional)
Jumbo craft stick (for puppet)

Options: Kids can use metallic crayons to color crown, or use gold paper crowns. **Prep:** Print Puppet page. Cut crown pattern from craft page. Use as a pattern. Cut out, lay on gold paper, trace, cut out crowns. **Standup:** Make copies onto cardstock. Cut out for children. **Craft:** Children color pictures. Glue on crown. Fold back tabs to stand. **Puppet:** Cut off tabs. Children color pictures. Glue craft stick to back.
